AVOID the 10 Solano County DUI Campaign will Conduct a DUI Checkpoint in Dixon on 12-19-2015

During the evening of Saturday, December 19, 2015 the Solano County DUI Coalition will be conducting a DUI Checkpoint in the City of Dixon.

As part of the national *Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over* enforcement campaign period, local law enforcement agencies will be working together in deploying DUI Checkpoints and DUI Saturation Patrols during the upcoming 17 day DUI Enforcement Campaign throughout our area. Due to the increase in drunk-driving related fatalities around the holidays each year, law enforcement agencies across America will be actively searching for and arresting drunk drivers from December 18th to January 3rd.

Law Enforcement emphasizes the preventable nature of drunk driving. All it takes is a little planning ahead to avoid drunk driving. The Solano County DUI Coalition reminds everyone to follow these simple tips to stay safe:

- Plan a safe way to get home before you attend a party. Alcohol impairs judgment, as well as reaction time. If you're impaired you're more likely to choose to drive drunk.
- Designate a sober driver.
- Take public transportation, a car service, or call a sober friend or family member to get a ride home.
- Walking while impaired can be dangerous, designate a sober friend to walk you home.
- If you see someone you think is about to drive while impaired, take their keys and help them get home safely.
