**City of Dixon Business License Renewals to Include  
\$1 Surcharge Mandated by Senate Bill 1186**

Governor Brown signed Senate Bill 1186 requiring cities to charge and collect a \$1.00 fee on each new or renewed business license beginning January 1, 2013. SB 1186 primarily amends the procedures for construction-related accessibility claims. One component of the bill seeks to bolster the Certified Access Specialist Program (CASp) administered by the State Architect and local governments.

The City of Dixon will comply with the legal mandate to impose an additional state fee of \$1.00 on all businesses. This will appear as Senate Bill 1186 charge on the renewal notice. The fee will be charged for new or renewed business licenses, including out-of-town businesses, non-profits, exempt businesses, and home-based businesses. The bill divides the money with 30% transmitted to the State Architect and 70% retained by the City for use in its CASp program and administrative costs.

This bill also requires local entities to transmit to local businesses information regarding compliance with and legal obligations under state disability laws. The \$1 surcharge will be in effect for business licenses issued between January 1, 2013 and December 31, 2018.

## THE CALIFORNIA SALES AND USE TAX MAY APPLY TO YOUR BUSINESS ACTIVITIES

### CALIFORNIA SALES AND USE TAX

The sales or use tax applies to most retail sales and leases of tangible personal property, including purchases from out-of-state retailers for use in California.

The Sales Tax is imposed on retailer of tangible personal property in California. However, retailers are authorized to reimburse themselves for the sales tax by collecting it from the consumer.

Every person in the business of selling property of a kind subject to the tax must apply to the Board of Equalization for a seller's permit. Wholesalers as well as retailers are included. There is no fee for the permit, but the applicant may be required to furnish security to assure payment of the tax.

Failure to pay the tax when due may result in the assessment of interest and penalties, in addition to the tax obligation.

### IF YOU ARE IN DOUBT HOW THE SALES AND USE TAX APPLIES TO YOUR BUSINESS, CONTACT US.

The best way to find out if the tax applies to your business activities is to contact the nearest Board of Equalization office and request written advice.

The Board staff will provide verbal responses to your questions and requests for advice. However, the law provides that the Board may relieve taxpayers to tax, interest, and penalties only where the Board finds that the failure to make a timely return or payment of sales or use tax was due to reliance on erroneous written advice by the Board staff.

To receive written advice, your inquiry must be in writing and must describe fully the specific facts and circumstances of the activities or transactions for which the advice is being requested.

### YOU SHOULD ALSO BE AWARE OF THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

1. All new signs must be approved by the Planning Commission unless the new sign is of the same size and style as a former sign on the property, and the former sign was approved by the City pursuant to Sec. 12.20 of the City's zoning ordinance.
2. The business use must be consistent with the City's zoning ordinance.
3. You will probably need a Building Code Compliance Inspection. Call (707) 678-7000.

The State of California, through statutory mandates, requires that certain businesses and/or individuals Obtain a license, registration or certification through the Division of Labor Standards Enforcement (DLSE) prior to commencing business and to maintain that license in good standing:

DLSE requires licenses for:

- Farm Labor Contractors
- Talent Agent
- Industrial Homework
  - License to Employ Industrial Home workers
  - Permit to Work as an Industrial Home worker
- Employers, supervisors and transporters of minors working in door-to-door sales

DLSE requires registration of:

- Garment Manufacturers/Contractors
- Car Wash and Polishing businesses

DLSE provides certification of:

- Studio Teachers

DLSE collects bonds for businesses engaging in:

- Fee-Related Talent Services

Finally, please note that an Entertainment Work Permit is required of all minors wishing to work in the Entertainment industry and any employer wishing to employ a minor in the entertainment industry is Required to complete an Application for Permission to Employ a Minor in the Entertainment Industry.
