

Our Reserves work side by side with career firefighters to handle calls in various disciplines such as: structure, wildland and vehicle fires, advanced medical emergencies, vehicle accidents, rope rescue, public assistance, water rescue, vehicle lockout and many more...



GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

- **THE CANDIDATE** shall be at least 18 years at the time of appointment
- **MUST HAVE** completed an approved Firefighter I Academy
- **ABILITY** to possess and maintain a First Responder Certificate
- **ABILITY** to possess and maintain a CPR Certificate
- **ABILITY** to satisfactorily complete Dixon Fire Department Recruit Class
- **ABILITY** to possess and maintain a valid Class C California Drivers License
- **A SATISFACTORY** driving record is a condition of initial and continued employment
- **RESIDENCY** within a 30 minute response time to Station 81

DESIRED QUALIFICATIONS

- Certified as a Firefighter I, II in the State of California
- Driver Operator 1A/1B course work
- CA DMV Class B drivers license
- High degree of mechanical aptitude
- Ability to think and act decisively
