

# *NFA Command and Control of Wildland Urban Interface Fire Operations for the Structural Chief Officer*



**Objective:** This 2-day course is designed to provide students with the essential tools and skills to operate safely in a Wildland/Urban Interface (W/UI) incident. Course content covers interface incidents, fire behavior, safety, and operational considerations. Chief or company officers who may have command responsibility for multiple resources at the scene of a W/UI incident are encouraged to attend. With the knowledge contained in this course, a structural chief officer will be able to make decisions effectively at a strategic level that will benefit all those involved including firefighters and the public. This class was designed for those individuals who do not deal with the W/UI issues on a regular basis and are looking for additional tools to be successful.

**Prerequisites:** None Students must completed a FEMA form 119-25-2 and are required to use a FEMA Student Identification Number SID. Please submit application prior to class.
