

Funding

Community Development Block Grant
(CDBG) Awarded to Dixon = \$1.1M

- ▶ For Public Improvements

Existing Conditions

- ▶ Pavement Rehabilitation Needed
 - “Alligator Cracking”
 - Thin Asphalt and Aggregate Base
- ▶ ADA Improvements Needed
- ▶ Sewer Replacement Needed
 - Several Cracks and Offset Joints
- ▶ Water Pipeline & Gas Pipeline
 - Relocated ahead of City Construction






Project Scope & Phases

- ▶ Utility Relocation
- ▶ Sewer Replacement
 - Mainline
 - Laterals
- ▶ ADA Reconstruction
 - Curb Ramps
- ▶ Pavement Rehabilitation
 - Full Depth Reclamation (FDR)
 - Fix rough surface





Lateral Replacement - Cleanouts




Full Depth Reclamation (FDR)






BETWEEN CHERRY ST & CHESTNUT ST




EXISTING TYPICAL SECTION

What to Expect During Construction

- ▶ Four Phases
 - Water Pipeline
 - Gas Pipeline
 - Sewer Pipeline
 - Street Rehabilitation & ADA ramps
- ▶ Impacts on motorists and residents
 - Limited road access during construction
- ▶ Daytime Construction

Next Steps

- ▶ Complete Design
- ▶ Coordinate Utility Relocations
- ▶ Bid Project for Construction
- ▶ Residents will be Notified Before Construction of Sewer & Road
