Union Pacific Railroad will be conducting rail safety work. The current plan is to close SR 113/ North First Street (between E Street and C Street) Monday morning, May 22, 2017-May 26, 2017.

Southbound SR 113 drivers shall use the Adams St. detour and northbound SR 113 drivers shall use either the Midway to I-80 detour or West A St. to the Adams St. detour for inter-City access.

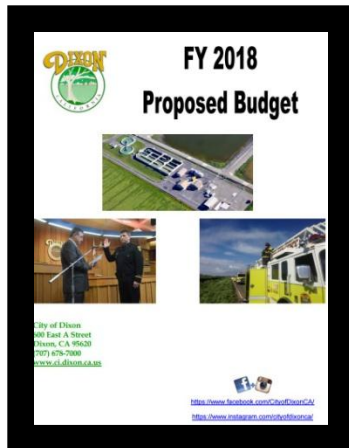

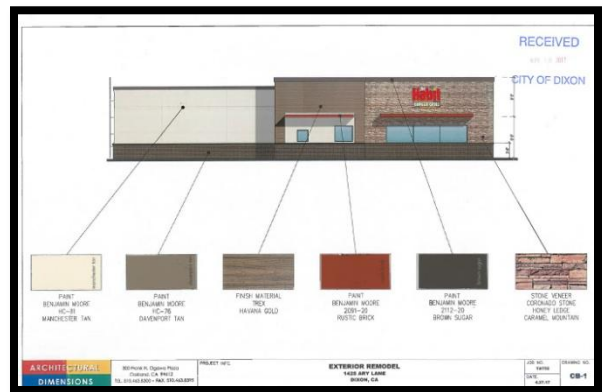
Also please welcome Police Recruit Joshua Bennett, who is expected to graduate from the Academy June 20<sup>th</sup>.

Planning is reviewing the submission at 1425 Ary Lane (former Arby's restaurant building). The plan is to upgrade the existing building both exterior and interior improvements. Design Review of the project will be presented at a public hearing of the Planning Commission in June.



**SALES TAX Update** – Dixon had a great fourth quarter with actual sales tax receipts for the October – December 2016 (most recent available) up 78.5%. Some of this includes a recently opened industrial supplies, and the recapture of sizable amounts of local taxes previously misallocated to other jurisdictions.
